The following guidelines will apply to Stuart Public School Activities for the 20-21 School Year. The purpose of the guidelines is to create a safer competition environment for students involved in the activities. The guidelines are subject to change as determined by the administration.

## **All Activities Guidelines**

1. The wearing of masks by spectators is strongly encouraged. Stuart Public School students in grades 4-12 will be required to wear masks just like during the school day in the gym.
2. Fans are asked to socially distance themselves from other spectators as much as possible during competition. Families are encouraged to sit together.
3. Players and coaches of visiting teams or groups are required to have their temperature checked before admittance into the gym. Visiting schools may do this on their own. Any individual with a temperature of 100.4 or above will not be allowed admittance.
4. People exhibiting symptoms of COVID-19 will not be allowed admittance.
5. Additional space will be created around the scorers table and home/visitor bench area of the gym to serve as a buffer between fans and student-athletes.
6. Children need to sit with their family and not be around the gym unsupervised.
7. The pep band will not play at indoor events at this time.
8. Fans are asked to leave immediately after the contest or event and not loiter in the gym at the conclusion of the contest.
9. The concession stand will be open following guidelines put forth by the North Central District Health Department.
10. Each NSAA member school will have different guidelines that they will ask fans to follow when arriving at their school. These guidelines will be given to team members to give to their parents and will be placed on the school website.

## **B. Football**

1. Fans are encouraged to socially distance and wear a mask.
2. Teams will be temp checked upon arrival at the gym, or will temp check before leaving their home school. Coaches will sign off and verify that their team has been temp checked.
3. Visiting teams will use the North locker room in the gym.
4. No pre or post game handshakes.
5. Visiting fans will be on the south side of the field. Home fans will be on the north side of the field.
6. The visiting team shall be on the south sideline. The visiting spotter and film crew will be in the south "crows nest". Masks are encouraged by members of the visiting team who are in the crows nest. Visiting cheerleaders will be on the south side of the field.
7. The home team shall be on the north sideline. The home spotter and film crew will be in the north press box. Masks are required to be worn in the north press box.
8. The home press box is limited to: announcer, clock personnel, and radio personnel.
9. The concession stand will be available.
10. Team members not in the game, coaches, managers, stat keepers and other members of the team party are encouraged to wear masks.
